CEASE AND DESIST ORDER

On July 1, 2022, the Texas State Board of Dental Examiners (Board) proposes this Cease and Desist Order (Order) against BRYANT ZELAYA.

The Board has received information and possesses certain evidence indicating that Bryant Zelaya has violated provisions of the Dental Practice Act (the Act), codified at Tex. Occ. Code §§ 251 through 257.

Failure to file a written request for a hearing on this Order prior to July 22, 2022, will render this Order immediately effective and non-appealable in accordance with Tex. Occ. Code § 264.0525(b).

Pursuant to authority granted at Tex. Occ. Code § 264.0525, the Board finds and issues the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

On March 1, 2022, the Board received a complaint concerning the unlicensed practice of dentistry by Bryant Zelaya. During the time period from October 20, 2021, through January 31, 2022, Bryant Zelaya performed dental procedures that included extracting teeth and placing brackets on teeth for the purpose of attaching braces on several patients at the location of 6401 Bingle Rd., Ste. 206, Houston, TX 77092, without holding a Texas dental license.

This conduct constitutes the unlicensed practice of dentistry, as defined by Tex. Occ. Code § 251.003, and is a violation of Tex. Occ. Code § 256.001 and may be subject to criminal prosecution.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

BRYANT ZELAYA, **CEASE AND DESIST** from any further action in the state of Texas in connection with the unlicensed practice of dentistry.
