CEASE AND DESIST ORDER

On June 17, 2021, the Texas State Board of Dental Examiners (Board) proposes this Cease and Desist Order (Order) against PATRICIA CARRANCO-CABRERA.

The Board has received information and possesses certain evidence indicating that Patricia Carranco-Cabrera has violated provisions of the Dental Practice Act (the Act), codified at Tex. Occ. Code §§ 251 through 257.

Failure to file a written request for a hearing on this Order prior to July 19, 2021, will render this Order immediately effective and non-appealable in accordance with Tex. Occ. Code § 264.0525(b).

Pursuant to authority granted at Tex. Occ. Code § 264.0525, the Board finds and issues the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

On October 15, 2020, the Board received a complaint concerning the unlicensed practice of dentistry by Patricia Carranco-Cabrera. On or about December 27, 2019, Patricia Carranco-Cabrera placed a filing on an upper molar of an individual at the location of 1700 Tantor Road, Dallas, Texas 75229, without holding a Texas dental license.

This conduct constitutes the unlicensed practice of dentistry, as defined by Tex. Occ. Code § 251.003, and is a violation of Tex. Occ. Code § 256.001 and may be subject to criminal prosecution.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

PATRICIA CARRANCO-CABRERA, **CEASE AND DESIST** from any further action in the state of Texas in connection with the unlicensed practice of dental hygiene.
